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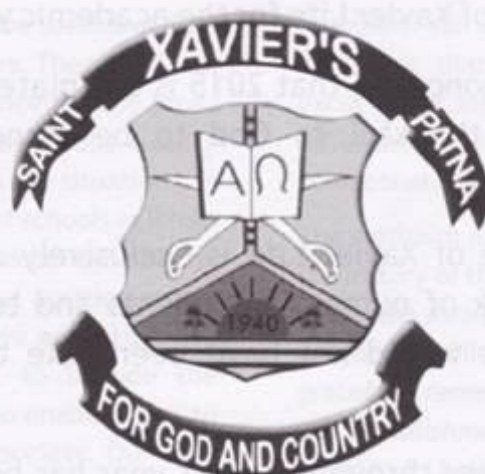

हमें प्यास क्यों लगती है?

हमारा विद्यालय इस बार शैक्षणिक पर्यटन के लिए हमें दक्षिण भारत का भ्रमण कराने ले जा रहा था। जब हमें यह बात पता चली तो हमारे दिल में खुशी की लहर दौड़ पड़ी। यह पर्यटन केवल सप्तम्, अष्टम् एवं नवम् वर्ग के विद्यार्थियों के लिए था। चूँकि यह हमारा पहला पर्यटन था इसलिए हम बेहद रोमांचित थे। तीन महीने के लंबे इंतजार के बाद आखिर वह घड़ी आ ही गई जिसका हमें बेसब्री से इंतजार था। हमारे चेहरे पर खुशी देखते ही बनती थी। बिहार राज्य से दक्षिण भारत का सफर लंबा था इसलिए हमने रेलगाड़ी का प्रयोग किया। गाड़ी खुली और हमने अपने-अपने माता-पिता को अलविदा कहा और अपनी मंगल यात्रा पर निकल पड़े। हम सभी इतने उत्सुक थे कि रेलगाड़ी पर हमें नींद ही नहीं आ रही थी। शरीर में नई ऊर्जा का संचार हो रहा था। मुँह से हँसी जा नहीं रही थी और आँखों से नींद मानो गायब ही हो गई थी।

आखिरकार तीन दिन के रेलगाड़ी से लंबे सफर के बाद हम पहुँचे चेन्नई। रेलगाड़ी से चेन्नई में उतरे तो चेन्नई की ठंडी समुद्री हवाओं ने हमारे चेहरे को स्पर्श किया और हमारी सारी थकावट दूर हो गई। हमने बस से होटल जाने का फैसला किया। शिक्षकगण ने बच्चों के लिए काफी अच्छे बस का बंदोबस्त कर रखा था। रास्ते भर चेन्नई की खूबसूरत व गगनचुंबी इमारतों का दृश्य काफी भव्य एवं मोहक था। सुबह तकरीबन पाँच बजे हम होटल पहुँचे और अपने-अपने कमरे में चल दिए। नहा-धोकर हम करीब आठ बजे चेन्नई घूमने चल दिए। हमने वहाँ अनेक प्राचीन मंदिर एवं चर्च देखें। फिर हम मरीना बीच पे गए जहाँ हमें सबसे ज्यादा मज़ा आया। यहाँ की लहरें काफी तेज थीं इसलिए हमारे शिक्षकों ने हमें तट पर ही रहने की हिदायत दी। यहाँ की लहर इतनी तेज थी कि हमारे पाँव पखार कर जा रही थी। ऐसा प्रतीत हो रहा था मानो चेन्नई की लहरें अपनी मेहमानबाजी अदा कर रही थीं। ‘मरीना तट’ घूमने के बाद हम अपने होटल को वापस चल दिए। उसके बाद फिर हम महाबलीपुरम तथा एम.जी. एम. एम्युज पार्क देखने गए। महाबलीपुरम में हमने एक विशालकाय मंदिर देखा, यह पाँचों पाँडवों का मंदिर था जो काफी प्राचीन व प्रसिद्ध था। उस जमाने में पत्थर पर उकेरी गई आकृतियाँ अपने आप में अनोखी थी। वहाँ हमें विभिन्न कला और संस्कृति के विस्मयकारी उदाहरण देखने को मिली। उसके बाद हम पहुँचे एम.जी.एम. एम्युज पार्क। इस पार्क में हमने बहुत मज़ा किया। यहाँ दूर-दूर तक पेड़-पौधे, उपवन तथा कई झूले हमारे मन को प्रफुल्लित कर रहे थे। यहाँ पर हमने दक्षिण भारतीय व्यंजनों का आनंद उठाया। सच में वे लाजवाब थे।

चेन्नई के बाद हमारी योजनानुसार हम मदुरई को निकल पड़े। चेन्नई से मदुरई की दूरी एक रात में पूरी हो गई। सुबह-सुबह मदुरई की खूबसूरती देखते ही बनती थी। हरे-हरे पेड़, ठंडी हवा और मीनाक्षी मंदिर का अद्भुत दृश्य अपने आप में काबिले तारीफ था। इसके बाद हम बस से यात्रा कर सीधे पहुँचे कोडाई केनाल। यह जगह ऊँचे पहाड़ों की गोद में था। यहाँ का दृश्य काफी मनमोहक था। नीचे हजारों फुट

खाई और ऊपर ऊँचे-ऊँचे पहाड़ और हमारे बीच बादल। दक्षिण भारत की गर्मी से हम भलीभाँती परिचित हैं पर कोडाई केनाल में हमें ठंड का अनुभव हो रहा था। दुकानों पर सजी रंग-बिरंगी मिठाईयों को देख हमारे मुँह में पानी आ रहा था। हमारे शिक्षकों ने हमारी मन की इच्छा को समझ, हमें मिठाई खरीदकर खाने की अनुमति दे दी। फिर हम अपने होटल लौट गए और वहाँ एक और दिन रुके।

कोडाई केनाल के बाद हम रामेश्वरम् के लिए चल पड़े। रास्ते में हमें केलों के बड़े-बड़े पेड़ मिल रहे थे। उसके बाद हम रामेश्वरम् में एक होटल में रुके। अगली सुबह हम भगवान् श्रीराम के दर्शन के लिए मंदिर गए। वहाँ हमने रामेश्वरम् के पावक समुद्र में श्रद्धा की डुबकी लगाई और सूर्य को जल अर्पित किया।

रामेश्वरम् के बाद हम अपनी यात्रा भारत के अंतिम दक्षिणी छोर कन्या-कुमारी के लिए तय की। हमने कन्या कुमारी में अनेक पवन चक्की व अशोक के पेड़ देखे। हम कन्या कुमारी मुख्य तौर पर सूर्योदय देखने गए थे। उस दिन नए साल का उत्सव भी था। नए साल की सूर्य की पहली लाल किरण हम भारत के अंतिम छोर से देख रहे थे। उस दिन सूर्य भी हमारे साथ लुका-छिपी का खेल खेल रहा था। अपने निर्धारित समय से कुछ देर बाद सूर्योदय हुआ। जब हमारे मुख पर निराशा छा गई तब बादलों ने अपना पट खोल सूर्य दर्शन होने दिया। सूर्य की पहली लाल किरणों ने हमें नववर्ष की हार्दिक शुभकामनाएँ दी। और हमारे चेहरे की चमक वापस आ गई। इसके बाद हम नहा-धोकर विवेकानंद रॉक मेमोरियल चल पड़े। यह जगह हमारे लिए अमृत कलश के समान था। विवेकानंद द्वारा दिए गए उपदेश और उनकी प्रेरणामयी बातें हमारे मन में भारत के प्रति प्रेम और भक्ति की भावना को और जागृत कर रही थी। उनकी बातें काफी उत्साहवर्द्धक थीं और सकारात्मकता से लवरेज

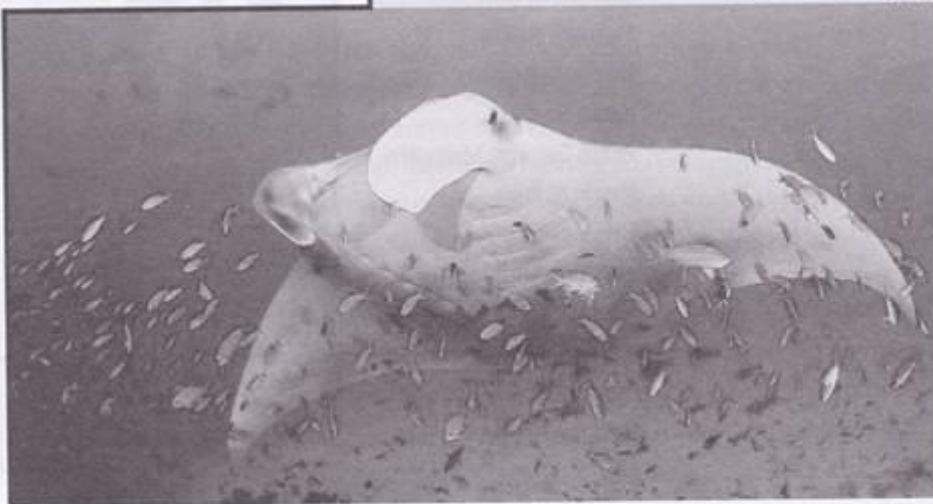

The Giant Oceanic Manta Ray

The "Giant Oceanic Manta Ray" (*Manta birostris*) is a species of Ray in the family Mobulidae and is the largest type of ray in the world. It is circum global and is typically found in tropical and subtropical waters, but can also be found in temperate waters.

Oceanic mantas are large, horizontally flattened fish that can grow to a width of 9m (30ft). They feed on plankton which they scoop up with their large mouths. Little is known of their reproductive habits but one (or occasionally two) live young are born after a gestation period of about a year. They reside in deep water, pelagic zones, making periodic visits to cleaning stations at seamounts and coastal reefs. Minimal concrete information exists on oceanic manta movements, but they are generally believed to be more transient and migratory than the smaller reef manta ray (*Manta alfredi*), which tends to be resident in shallower coastal habitats.

The Mongol Empire

"Inhuman and beastly, rather monsters than men..." is how the English historian Matthew Paris described the Mongols in 1200s. Mongol armies sent a shockwave of fear around Asia and Europe, conquering a vast area of land that formed the largest empire in history.

The MONGOLS lived on the plains of Central Asia, from the Ural mountains to the Gobi Desert. They were nomads, wandering with their herds and living in portable tents (yurts). Their leaders were called Khans. In 1206, Temujin Khan brought all the tribes under his rule and was proclaimed

Genghis Khan, "lord of all". In a lifetime of conquest, he seized an empire that extended from the Pacific Ocean to the river Danube, incorporating the Persian empire. The Mongols continued their attacks after Genghis Khan died. In 1237 a Mongol army led by Batu Khan, one of Genghis's sons, invaded Russia.

In Europe, people panicked as words had spread of the Mongols' speed and ferocity in battle. Mongol soldiers travelled with five horses each and were expert with bows and lances. In victory, they were merciless, slaughtering the people of a city and carting away treasure. Western Europe was saved only when the Mongols turned homeward on the death of their leader Ogadai Khan in 1241.

Alexander and the Persians



After the squabbles following the Persian Wars, Macedonia became the dominant force in Greece. Its young king, Alexander, led his armies on an epic march of conquest, crushing the Greeks' traditional enemies, the Persians.

The Persian homeland was in what is now Iran. The Persians had come to rule an empire that stretched eastward to India and as far west as Turkey. Great Persian kings, such as Cyrus the Great, commanded huge and efficient armies. Darius I (521-486 BC) built fine roads for carrying messages quickly across the empire, which he reorganized into provinces called satrapies. From 499 BC, Persia turned against the Greeks, but in 480 BC its invasion fleet was defeated at the battle of Salamis.

Power then swung towards Greece. In 338 BC Macedonia's Warrior king Philip II gained control of all the Greek states by victory at Chaeronea. When Philip was murdered in 336 BC, his son Alexander became king, aged 20. It took Alexander just 13 years to conquer the largest empire in the ancient world, spreading Greek and Persian culture far and wide.

In 334 BC Alexander led his army against the Persians. He wanted not only to conquer their lands, but also replenish his royal treasuries. In 333 BC he defeated the Persian king Darius III at the Battle of Issus, and by 331 BC he had conquered the whole of Persia and had become its king. To strengthen the ties between the two, Alexander included Persians in his government. He also wore Persian clothes and married a Persian princess, Roxane. He went on to invade India, defeating King Porus at the battle of the river Hydaspes. It was to be his final expedition. His exhausted army refused to go on. Alexander was forced to retreat to Babylon. He died there of a fever in 323 BC, aged 32. After his death, the empire was divided among his leading generals.

The International Space Station

The International Space Station (ISS) Program's greatest accomplishment is as much a human achievement as it is a technological one. An international partnership of space agencies provides and operates the elements of the ISS. The International Space Station Program brings together international flight crews, multiple launch vehicles, globally distributed launch operations, training, engineering, and development facilities; communications, networks, and the international scientific research community.

Construction, assembly and operation of the International Space Station requires the support of facilities on the Earth managed by all of the international partner agencies and countries involved in the program. These include construction facilities, launch support and processing facilities, mission operations support facilities, research and technology development facilities and communication facilities.

The International Space Station (ISS) is a working laboratory orbiting 240 miles above the Earth and is home to an international crew. The station has more than 15,000 cubic feet of habitable volume, which includes more room than a conventional three-bedroom house.

The station provides a laboratory complex where gravity, a fundamental force on Earth, is virtually eliminated for extended periods. The ability to control the variable of gravity in experiments creates unimaginable research possibilities.

The Station is vital to human exploration. It is where we are learning how to combat the physiological effects of being in space for long periods. The space station is our test bed for technologies and our decision-making processes when things go as planned and when they don't. It is important to learn and test these things 240 miles up rather than encountering them 240,000 miles away while on the way to Mars or beyond.

The International Space Station marked its 10th anniversary of continuous human occupation on Nov. 2, 2010. Since Expedition 1, which was launched on the Oct. 31, 2000, and docked Nov. 2, the space station has been visited by 2014 individuals. A total of 168 spacewalks have been conducted in support of space station assembly totaling more than 1,061 hours, or more than 44 days. The space station, including its large solar arrays, spans the area of a U.S. football field, including the end zones, and weighs 9,24,739 pounds.

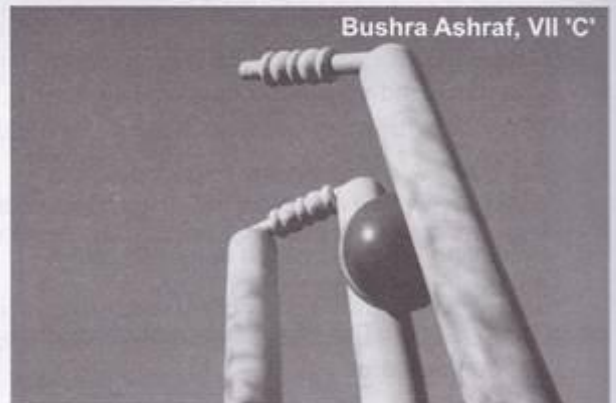

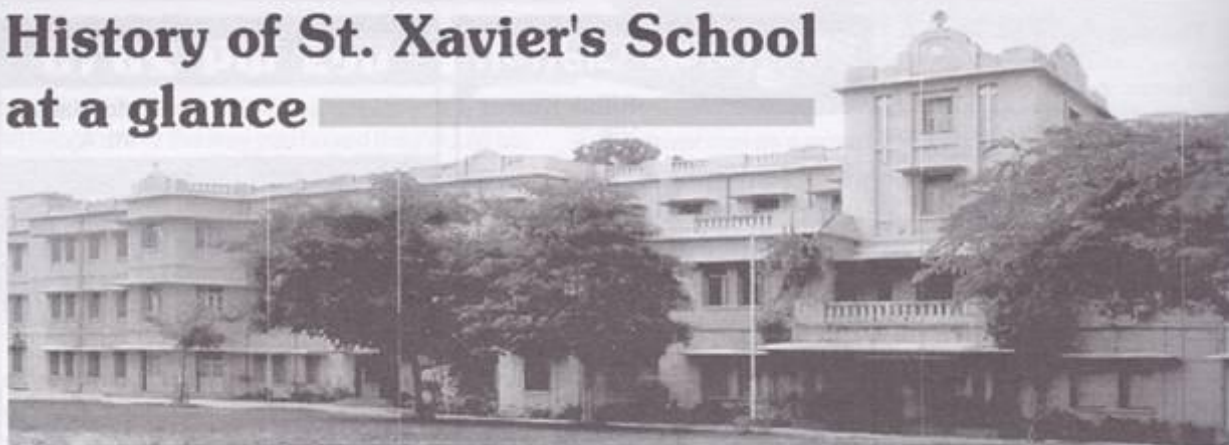
समर कैप चित्रकला

History of St. Xavier's School at a glance



St. Xavier's School Patna is an institute of Education established in 1940 to mould young men and women "for God and Country", which is the motto of the school. The school is run by the Patna Province of the Society of Jesus, an international catholic religious order known for its commitment to education. The Jesuit tradition has a distinguished history spanning five centuries and has, in every age, pursued and delivered educational excellence. The passion for quality sets demanding standards for both students and faculty and encourages them to apply their well-learned lessons and skills to achieve new ideas, better solutions, and vital answers. Such commitment of the Society of Jesus to the cause of education has been one of the major factors accounting for the origin of St. Xavier's Patna.

In the late 1930's two eminent men of Bihar, Shri Krishna Sinha and Anugraha Narain Sinha, approached Fr. Frank Loesch, S.J., the Jesuit Superior of the Patna Mission with a proposal of setting up a school affiliated to the Cambridge education system in order to impart quality education to the people of Patna and Bihar. Fr. Frank Loesch, S.J., accepted the proposal. However the driving force behind the establishment of St. Xavier's was Fr. Marshall Moran, S.J., Secretary and Assistant to Fr. Frank Loesch, S.J. St. Xavier's opened its door to the youth of Patna and Bihar in January 1940 and Fr. Marshall Moran, S.J., was appointed the first Principal of the school. The first student admitted was Ramanandan Prasad. He was the son of Jadunandan Prasad an advocate living in Bakerganj, Patna.

St. Xavier's Patna was the first Senior Cambridge School for Indian students in Bihar. Its primary purpose at that time was to prepare leaders for the country by providing them with excellent education. Consequently, the students of the school played an important role in the defense services, civil administration and industrial development of India. Such as Salman Khursheed, Minister of External Affairs, Govt. of India, Arun Singh, Indian Envoy to France, Sushil Kumar Modi, the Deputy Chief Minister of Bihar, Dilip Sinha India's permanent Envoy to the United Nations in Geneva, Jayant Das Gupta, India's Ambassador to the World Trade Organization in Geneva, Yash Sinha, India's new Envoy to Sri Lanka, Amar Sinha, the New Indian Ambassador to Afghanistan, Abhyanand 48th DGP, Bihar, etc. The list of them can never be exhausted.

The year 1968-69 marked a turning point in the history of St. Xavier's. In that period the Patna Jesuit Fathers decided to shift the Cambridge School to St. Michael's, which was also run by them, and have St. Xavier's affiliated to the CBSE Higher Secondary Department, New Delhi. In 1970, Fr. Scaria Mammoottil, S.J., the Principal applied for affiliation to the CBSE, New Delhi; after first being granted temporary affiliation St. Xavier's remained affiliated to the CBSE, New Delhi till the 30th April 1976.

In 1972 St. Xavier's applied for affiliation to the Bihar Board. Permission to open the school was granted on the 4th December 1972. St. Xavier's became a Hindi Medium school in 1975 and was granted permanent recognition on the 4th January 1977. The school was declared a Minority school in 1978. Hence St. Xavier's decided to educate the less privileged in society by getting affiliated to Bihar Board. St. Xavier's committed itself to educate the poor and underprivileged. Over the years, the school has tried to help the oppressed to take their rightful place in society. The Jesuit society understood the education of women is very essential. Therefore St. Xavier's gives special importance to the education of girls. At present there are 3162 students are being educated among whom 2187 boys and 975 girls.

Our strong commitment to human values and social justice stems from the Jesuit ideal of "faith that does justice." In pursuit of that mission, St. Xavier's students strive to live as men and women "for God and country", seeking to achieve great things not only for themselves, but also for their communities and society as a whole.
